Non-material correction to Non-Executive Director fees in Annual Report and Accounts

Although not material, the Company is providing the below information for full transparency.

Due to an incorrect extraction, the figures on page 103 of the Company's FY 2023 Annual Report and Accounts, slightly overstate the increase in the Board Chair and other Non-Executive Directors' fees from 1 January 2024.

As the footnote to the table "Fees for Non-Executive Directors and the Chair" explains, the increase to be applied from 1 January 2024 is 4.3%, which is below the base salary increase for UK employees.

The figures in the table in the Annual Report incorrectly reflect a slightly higher increase. The correct figures are shown in the yellow column below, on the right:
